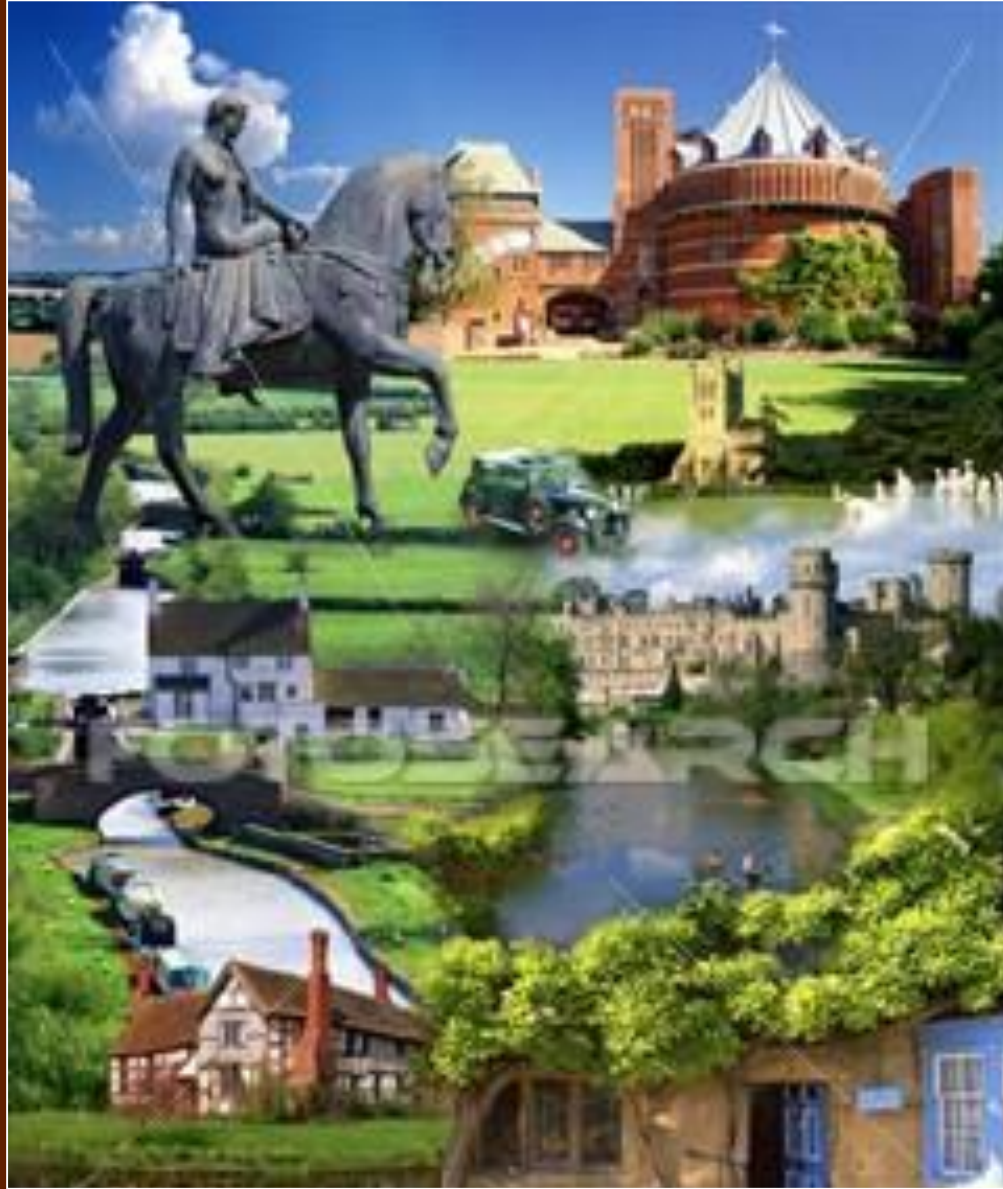


# William Shakespeare

He was born on the 23rd of April, 1564 , in a small English town Stratford – upon – Avon.

He was born in a family of glove – maker.







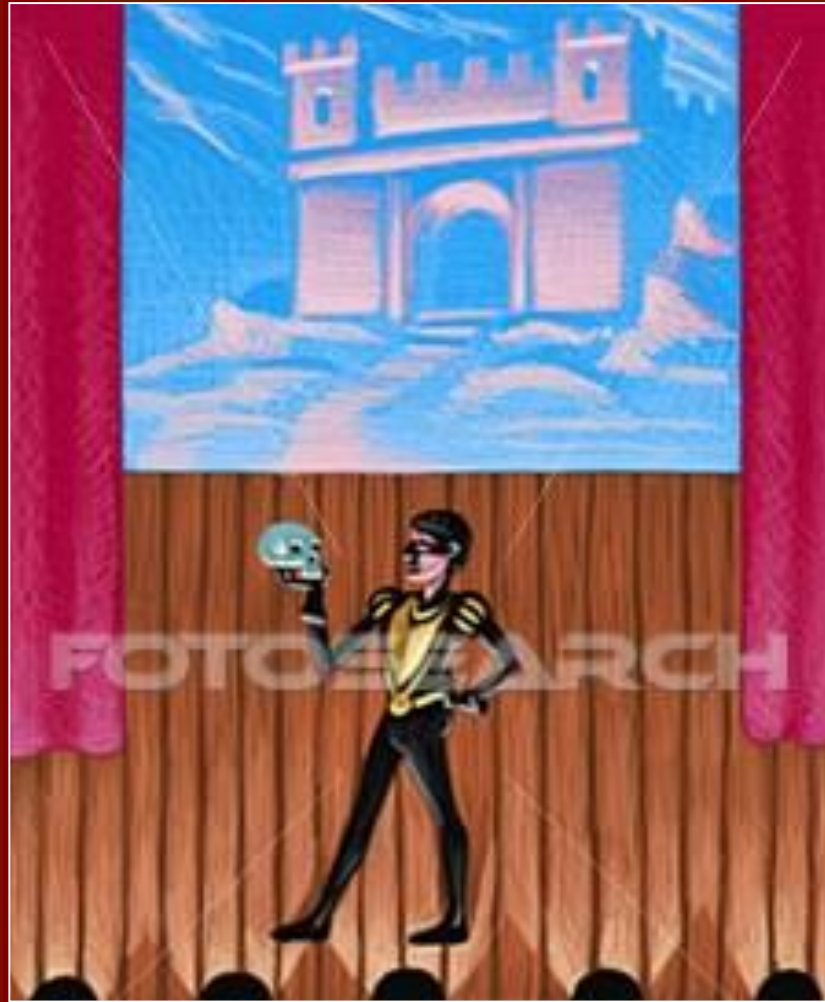
At the age of 6 to 13 he studied  
at the grammar school.

Stratford – on – Avon.



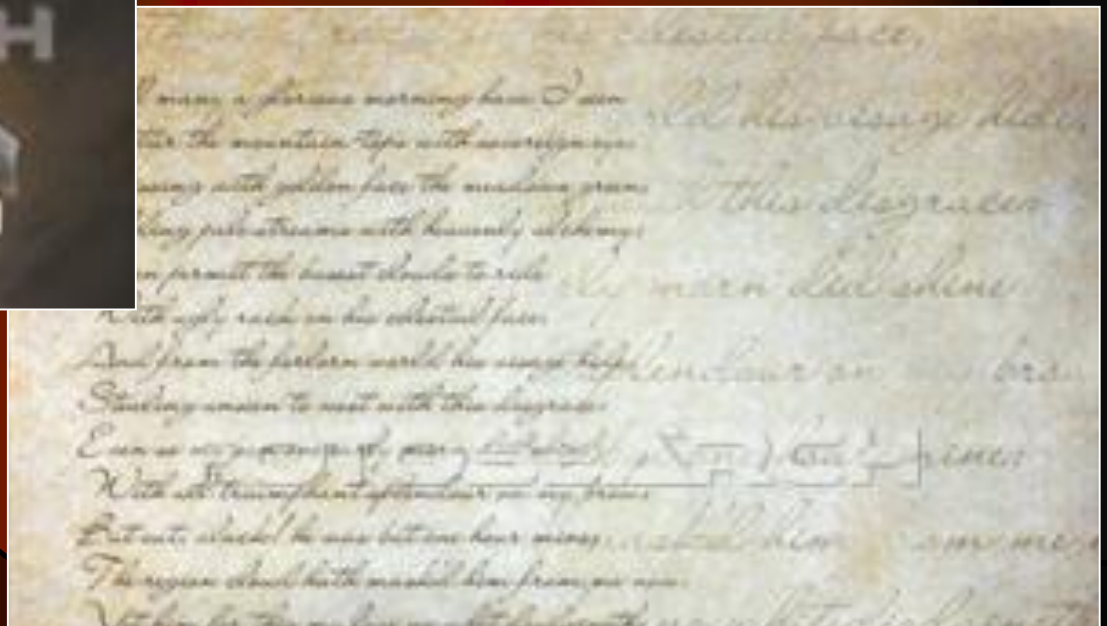
William liked to watch them. He was fond of their

When he was 21 he went to London.

He began to write plays too.

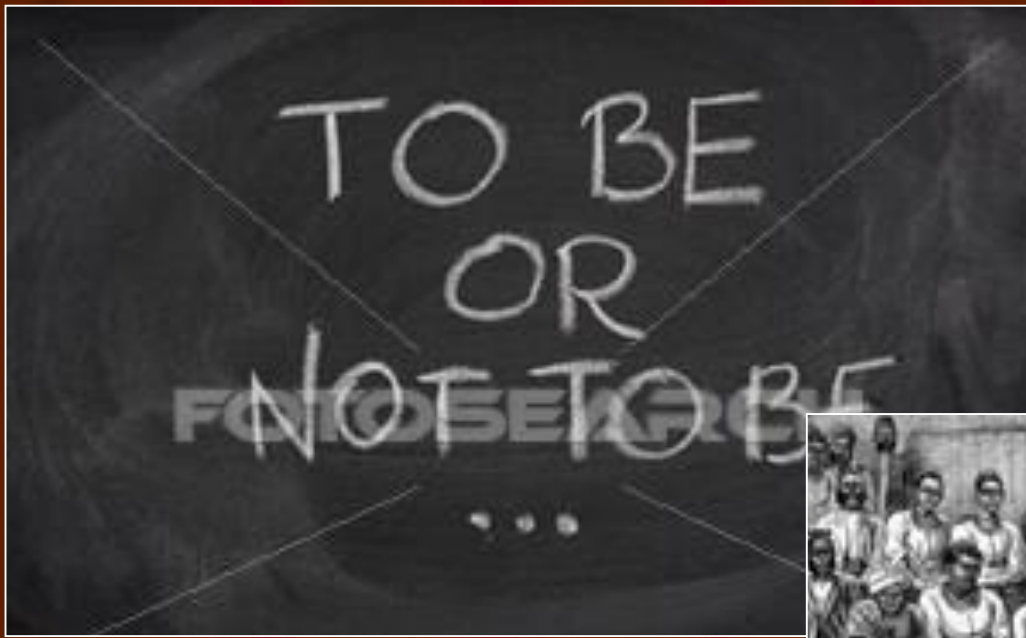
Shakespeare was

37 plays

10 tragedies - such as  
“Hamlet”, “King Lear”,  
“Othello” and “Macbeth”.







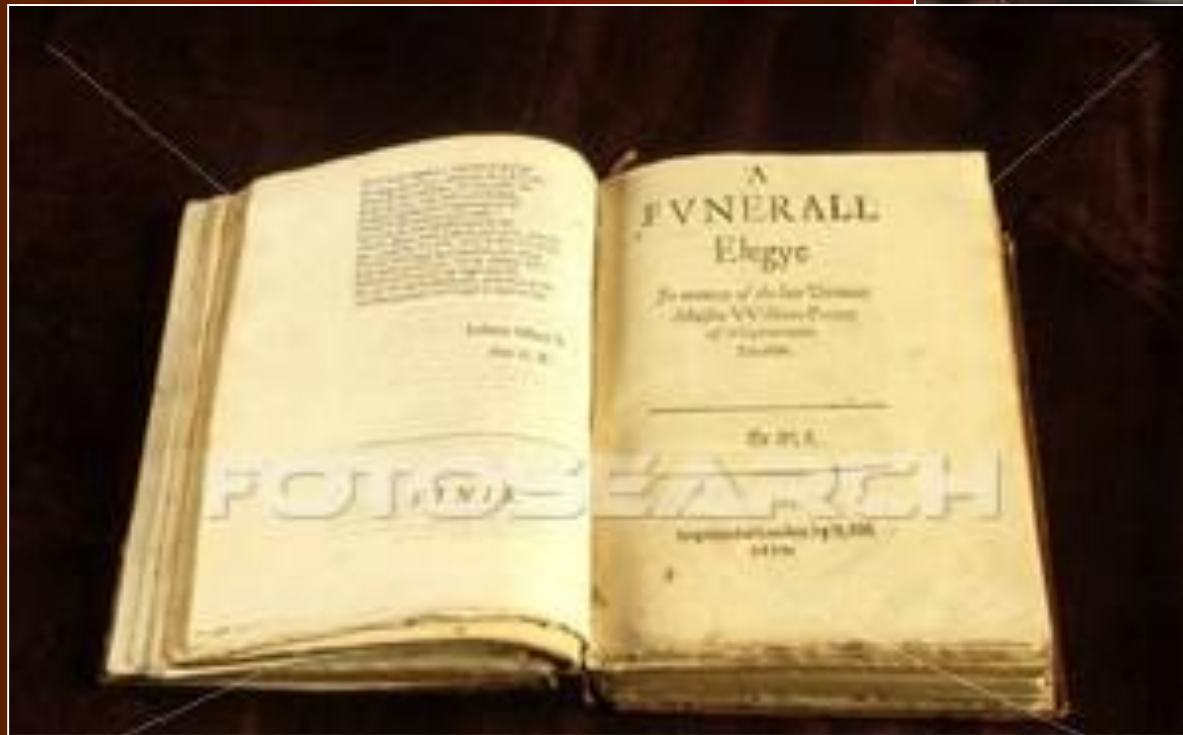
17 comedies – such as  
“As You Like It”,  
“Twelfth Night”,  
“Much Ado About Nothing”.

He also left 7 books of poems.

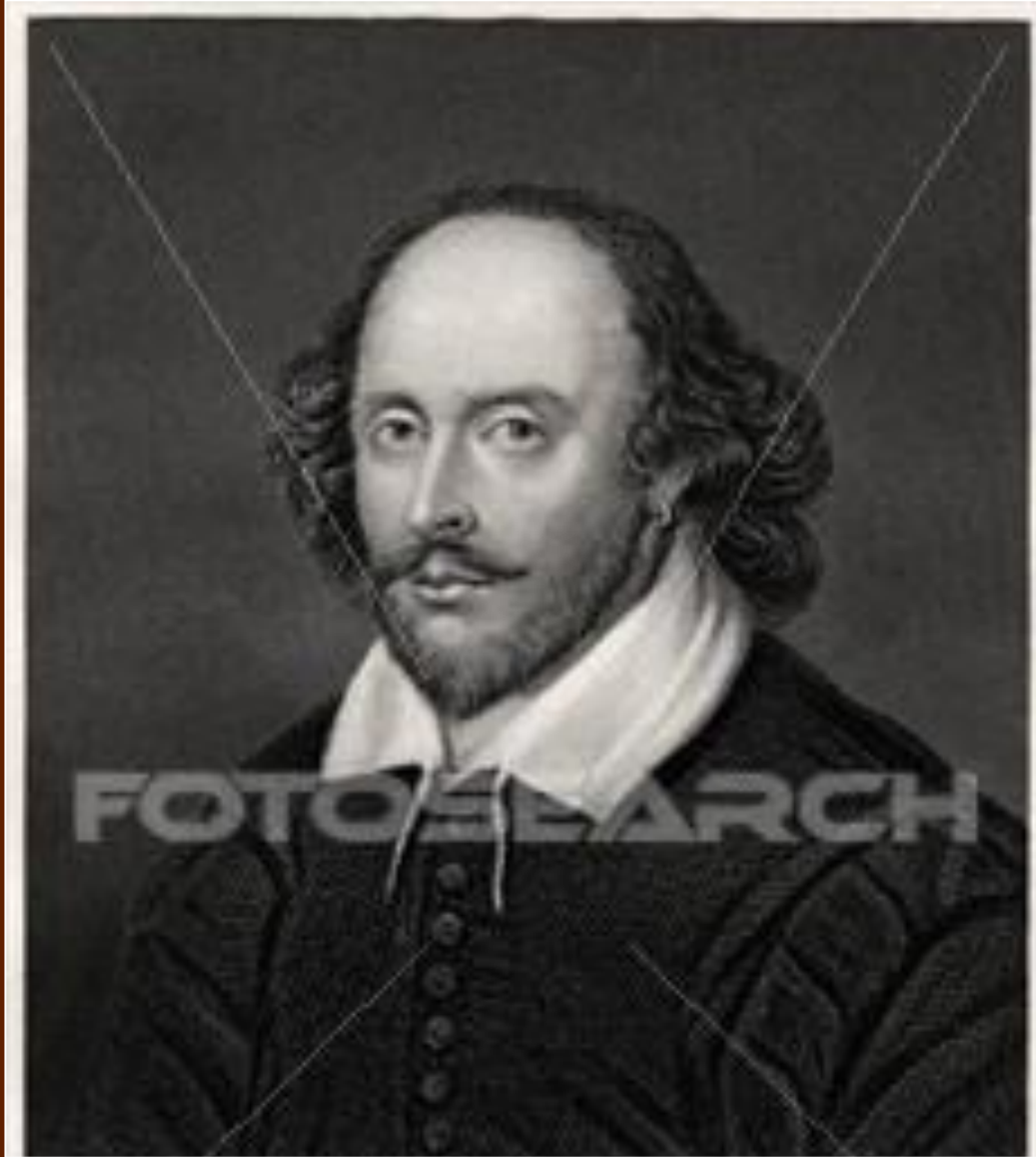


His plays and poems have
