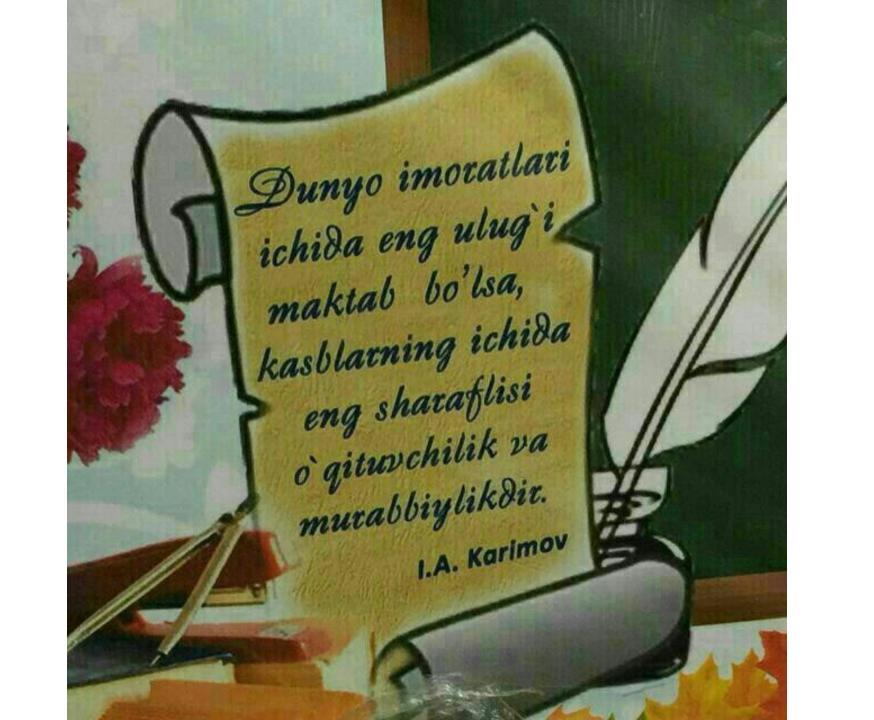

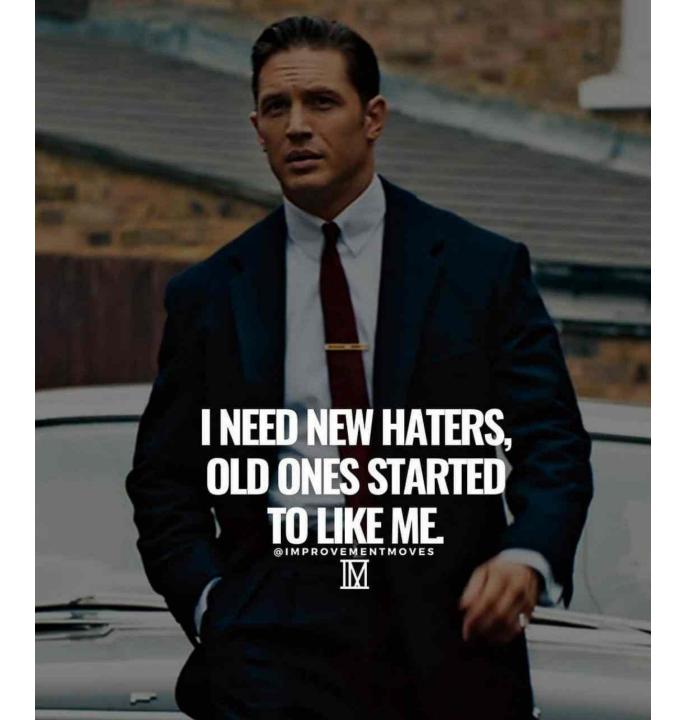

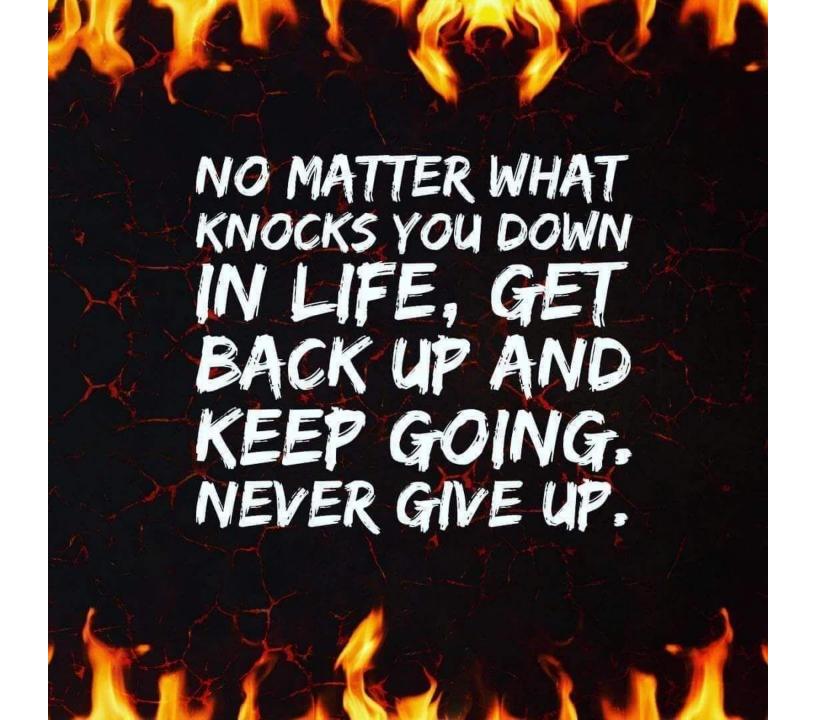

How to pass the **IELTS**

Plan your trip



- You will receive an e-mail describing the location of the test centre according to your ID 2 or 3 days before the test.
- Choose how to get to the test centre and find out how long it takes.
- *You need to arrive at the test centre before 9:30 a.m. and be registered before 9:50, because the test always starts at 10:00.
- Be sure to bring your international passport.

Test venue:

- When you come to the test room, you will see the place reserved specially for you.
- No electronic devices and food (except for water) are allowed at the workplace during the test.
