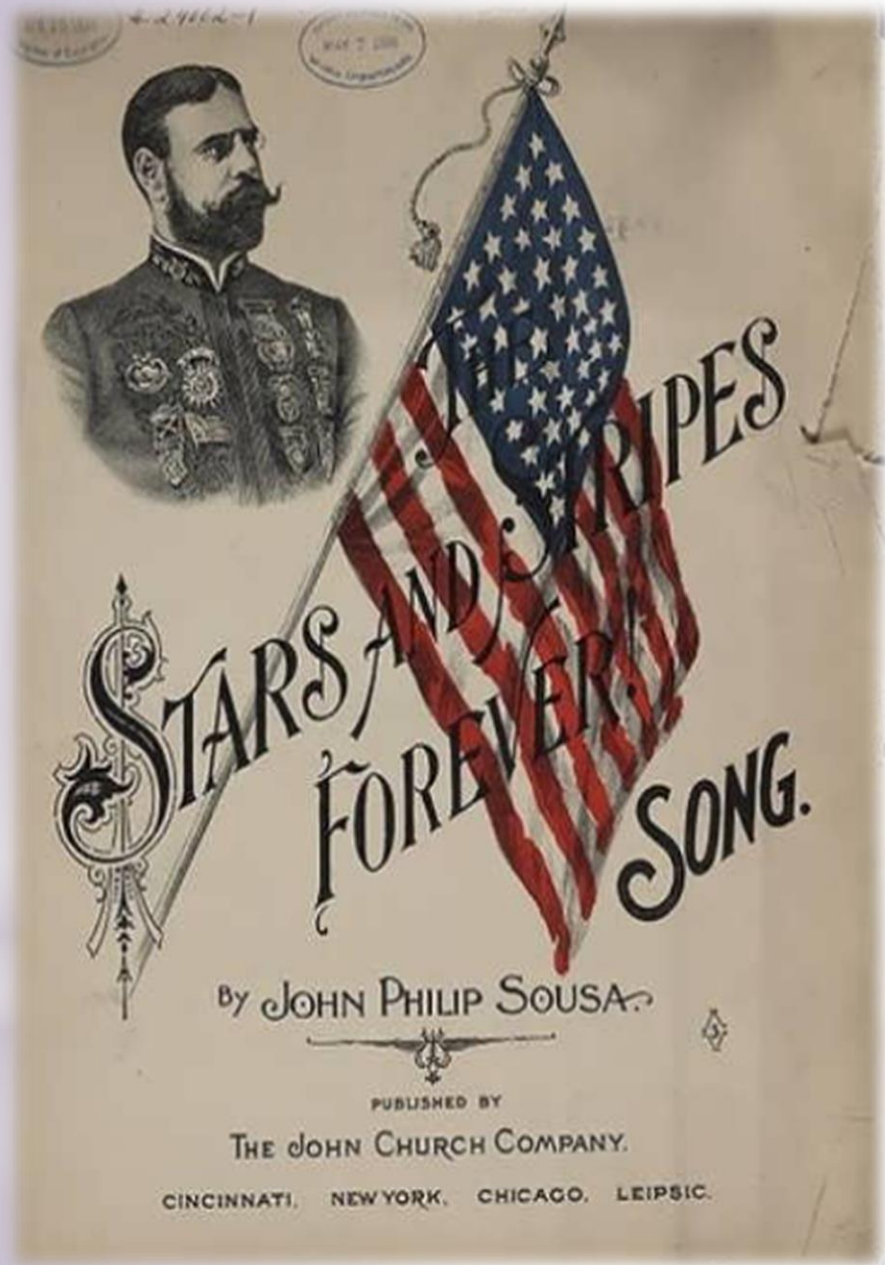


* The flag of the United States is commonly known as the “Stars and Stripes” or “Old Glory”

* The Bald Eagle is the national bird of the USA and is represented on its Seal. In the late 20th century it was on the brink of extirpation in the continental United States.





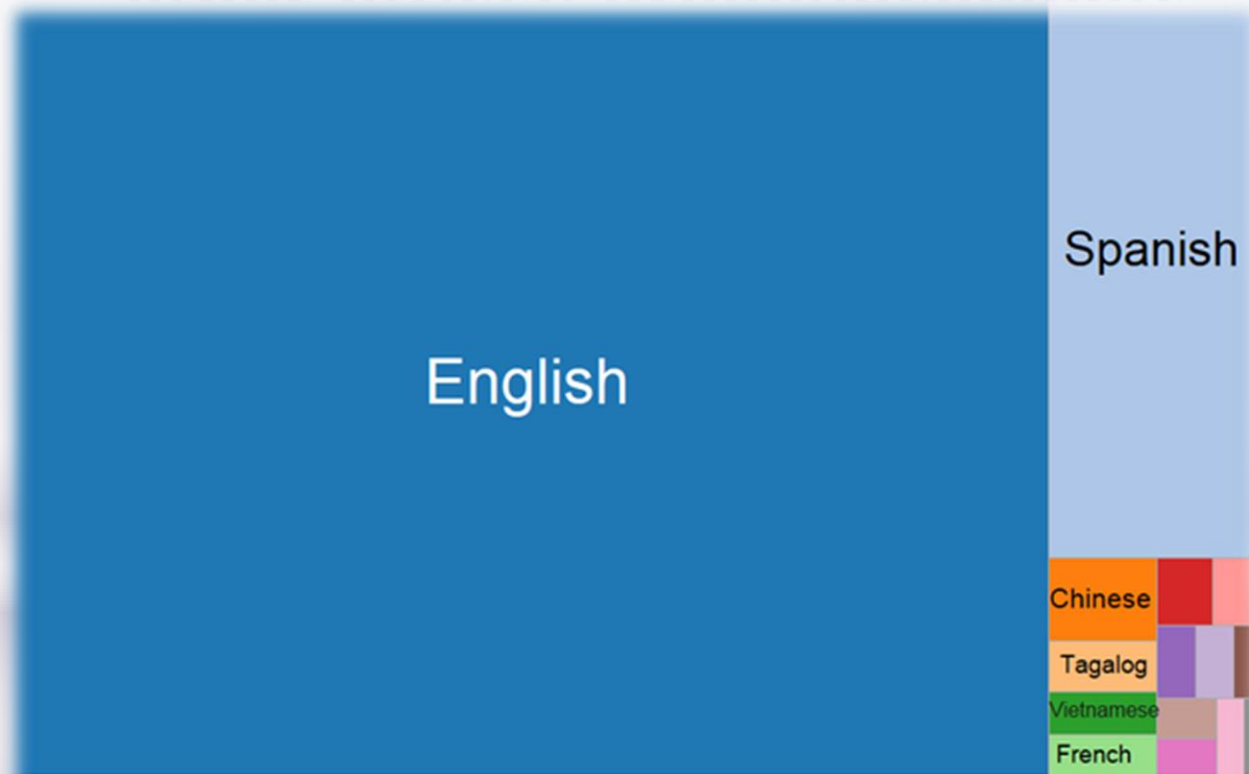
* Oak tree is the national Tree of Unites States of America. Oak tree was adopted as the National tree of United States in Nowember.

There is no official language of the United States although English is the primary language used for legislation, regulations, executive orders and all other official pronouncements.



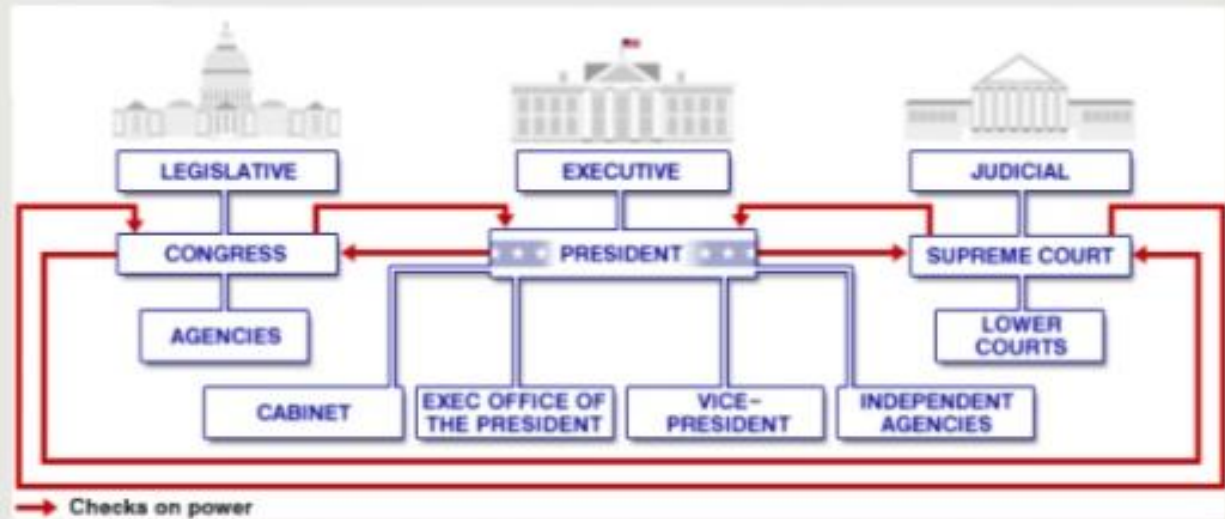
*The Political System of the USA.
