Canada is divided into 10 provinces.

A province is a political boundary that divides Canada into different regions.

Provinces are equivalent to E.U.A states.

Canada stretches from the Pacific Ocean on the west, to the Atlantic Ocean on the east. Northern Canada reaches into the Arctic Circle, while southern Canada stretches below the northern points of the U.S.A.

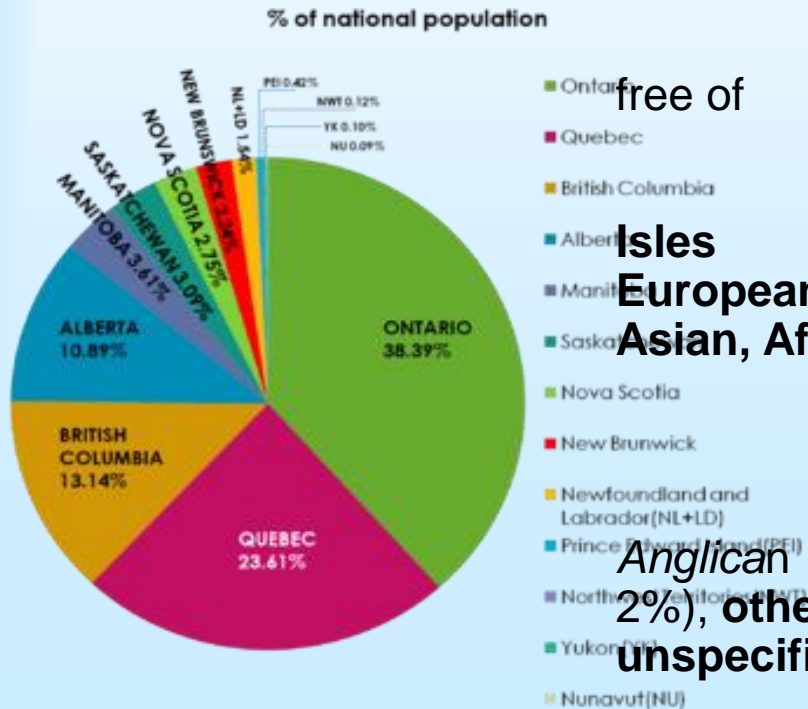

- Canada is the ninth-most sparsely populated nation in the world with a population density of 8.6 people per square mile⁸.
- Around 33.4 million people live in Canada, and the population is growing by 0.9 percent annually².
- Canada's per-capita immigration rate is one of the highest in the world with about 250,000 immigrants being admitted yearly since 2006⁷.

The Great Seal of Canada is a seal used for official purposes of state in Canada such as the certification of Acts of Parliament that have been granted Royal Assent.

- ★ Other national parks are Gwaii Haanas national park, jasper national park, cape Breton highlands national park etc.



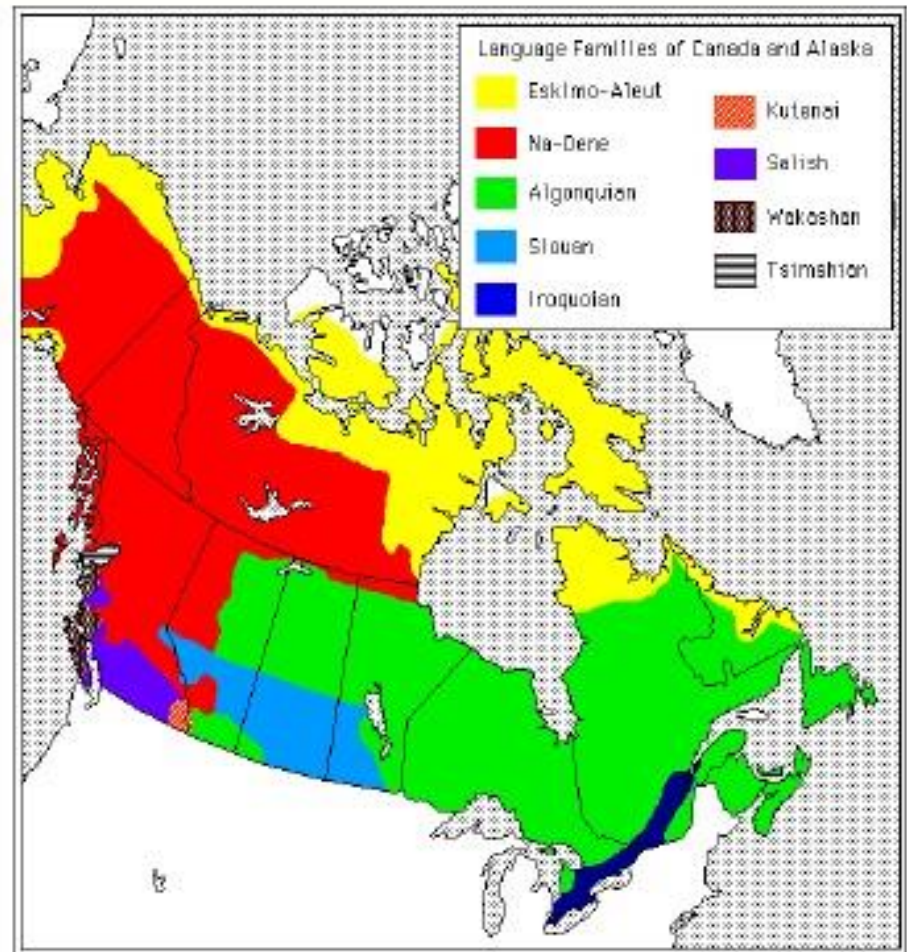
