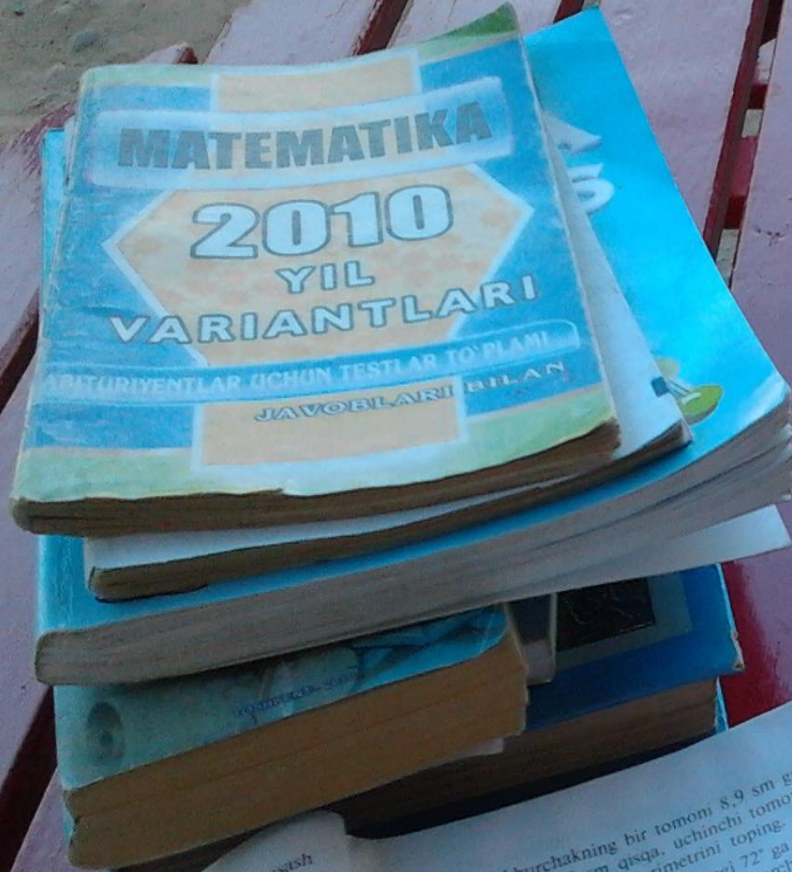




My favourite books
