National Flower of USA

Rose is the national flower of USA. The Congress, by Senate Joint Resolution 159 accepted Rose as The National Emblem of USA. On November 20, 1989 President Ronald Reagan proclaimed Rose as National Floral Emblem of USA.



National Bird of USA

The Bald Eagle is the National Bird of USA. The Bald Eagle was adopted as the National Bird of United States in 1782. The Bald Eagle symbolizes strength, courage, freedom and immortality.



13 stars in the crest above the eagle



13 stripes in the shield upon the eagle's breast

13 arrows in the eagle's left claw

13 olives and leaves in the eagles' right claw

13 letters in the motto carried by the eagle, *E Pluribus Unum*

Political system and language



The US has a complex political system

The US Government is divided into three clearly defined branches – the president and his cabinet (the executive), the US Congress (the legislature) and the courts (the judiciary).

The separation of powers is designed to provide a system of checks and balances which prevent any individual or group from gaining too much control.

The Golden Gate Bridge is a suspension bridge spanning the Golden Gate, the strait between [San Francisco](#) and Marin County to the north. The Golden Gate Bridge was the longest suspension bridge span in the world when it was completed in 1937, and has become an internationally recognized symbol of San Francisco and [California](#).

Thanksgiving Day

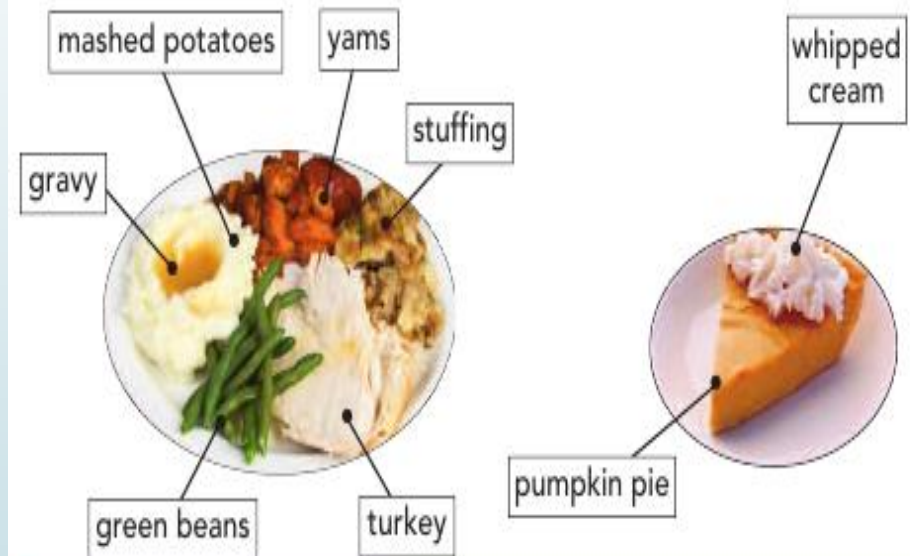
Thanksgiving is the second Monday in October.

Turkey and pumpkin pie are popular at Thanksgiving.

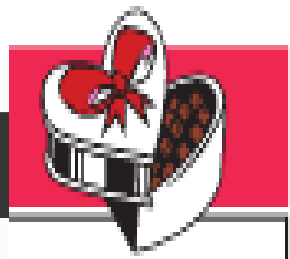


What's for Thanksgiving dinner?
