

opposite

Prepositions of place go before a noun.

in London close to the school behind the market

I live close to/near to the city centre.

I live far from the city centre.

They live next to my house.

Her house is in front of the school.

There's a big garden behind the house.

The flat is opposite the hospital.

I work at home.

Not I work in home.

How many bedrooms are there? There are 32 bedrooms.

A, an, some & any

a/an

Use a/an with single nouns.

I have a desk in my room.

some

Use *some* with plural nouns and affirmative sentences.

There are some lamps here.

any

Use *any* with plural nouns in questions and with plural nouns in negative sentences.

Do you have **any** curtains? There aren't **any** boys here.
