Lesson 1 - Idioms with A

Study part

According to Hoyle

- to play (usually a card game) by the established and accepted rules.

Origin: Edmund Hoyle was an Englishman who wrote rules for card games and recognized as an expert.



For example: 1. According to Hoyle, in this game you can't pick up more than one playing card. 2. This doesn't seem ethical to me. Are you sure that what we are doing is according to Hoyle?

Synonyms: (go) by the book; on the up and up (sentence 2).

Uzbek: Chumchuq so 'ysa ham qassob so 'ysin. Qonun qoidasiga ko'ra.

Russian: по словам Хойла. делать что-либо строго по правилам; делать что-либо привычным и правильным образом

Ace up one's sleeve

-To have an effective but hidden means to accomplish something.

Origin: The expression probably originates from card games like poker in which someone might hide an extra ace up his sleeve to use in case he was losing the game and wanted to cheat.



For example: 1. It looks like Joanne is going to lose, but I wouldn't be too sure. She may have an ace up her sleeve.

Uzbek: Zimdan ish ko'rmoq

Russian: туз в рукаве; козырь про запас; козырь в рукаве; скрытое преимущество

Achilles' heel

-A person's weakness or the vulnerable spot in his or her character.

Origin: Achilles was a figure in Greek mythology who was invulnerable in battle except for his heel. It was the one weak spot on his body.

For example: 1. We've got to find his Achilles' heel if we hope to defeat him. 2. John appears to be a highly respected citizen, but I'm sure he has his *Achilles' heel*.

Uzbek: Axilisning tovoni; Zaif nuqtasi.; Nozik joyi

Russian: ахиллесова пята; точка бегства



The Acid Test

-The most crucial and important test of worth.

Origin: The expression probably originates from the use of nitric acid on gold to determine if it was genuine.

For example: 1. Parents might be willing to buy this new toy for their children but the real acid test is whether or not the children themselves like it. 2. The acid test of a laundry soap is not how well it cleans in cold water.

Uzbek: jiddiy sinov

Russian: кислотный тест, серьезной проверкой
