


## \* HISTORY

- \* formally declared independence from Spain on July 9, 1816




## \* POLITICS RIVISION


- \* PROVINCES: 23

- \* DENSITY: 14.43 hab/km<sup>2</sup>






\* MEAN VALUES (1971-2000)






### \* DISTANCE TO OCEANS AND WINDS


- \* Daily and seasonal temperature amplitud is influenced by oceans proximity
- \* Climate is influenced by the distance to anticyclones.
- \* Winds from the Pacific Ocean are dry
- \* Winds from the Atlantic Ocean are humid (rains)




## \* RIFFEBENT CLIMATES

\* Warm: \* Avg Temp: 12 to 27 °C \* Prec: 600 to 2000 mm/yr \* Moderate: \* Avg Temp: 15°C \* Prec: 500 to 1000 mm/yr \* Arid: \* Avg Temp: 5 to 20 °C \* Prec: up to 400 mm/yr \* Cold: \* Avg Temp: 7°C \* Prec: up to 600 mm/yr. Snowing season during winter time
