The concept of development of physical education and sports was developed by implementing the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On Physical Education and Sports".

In order to further develop physical education and mass port in Uzbekistan, strengthen its material and technical base, train and educate a new generation of athletes, and increase the international prestige of our country's sports, the

PF-5847 dated October 8, 2019 of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On approval of the concept of development of the higher education system of the Republic of Uzbekistan until 2030" and PF-5763 dated July 11, 2019 "Higher and o Decree "On measures to reform management in the field of secondary special education" and the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated July 11, 2019 No. PQ-4391 "Introduction of new principles of management in the system of higher and secondary special education" taking into account that in the decision on measures" aimed at increasing the efficiency of the use of information and communication technologies, Internet and multimedia resources in the higher education system, the most important aspect of the reforms in the field is that the consistent implementation of information and communication technologies in the higher education system bringing the content of education up to the level of world standards as a result of the strengthened the process of reconciliation. In this regard, as the Honorable President noted, "In order to achieve development, it is necessary and necessary for us to acquire digital knowledge and modern information technologies. Mirziyoyev, issued the Presidential Decree No. Decision (1) on the program for the further development of physical education and mass sports in the Republic of Uzbekistan in 2017-2021 PQ No. 3031 dated June 3, 2017, "On measures for the further development of physical education and mass sports" (2) in our country Further development of physical education and sports, selection of children and adolescents for annual and multi-year preparatory training, and attention is paid to the issues of finding talented young people and directing them to narrow specialties. the priority tasks of athletes are defined in these decrees. It is related to the high level of technical training. This is one of the urgent issues of preparing reserve athletes for tomorrow.

DISCUSSION

In our republic, consistent measures are being taken to popularize physical education and sports, to promote a healthy lifestyle among the population, and to ensure the country's proper participation in international sports arenas. The main attention of our state is the creation of a legislative system for the population, especially the youth, to regularly engage in physical education and sports, as well as to improve their health. Including the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On Physical Education and Sports" dated September 5, 2015, the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On Measures for the Further Development of Physical Education and Mass Sports" dated June 3, 2017 Resolution No. 3031 of January 24, 2020, Decree No. 5924 "On measures to further improve and popularize physical education and sports" is an important factor in the further popularization of physical education and sports in our country. This improves the educational process and creates a wide opportunity for young people to grow both physically and mentally [1]

In the development of independent Uzbekistan, the development of physical education, physical culture and sports is particularly noteworthy. President Sh. M. Mirziyoev's great attention serves as the foundation of our achievements. The importance of physical education and sports development in terms of forming a healthy lifestyle, improving the health of the nation's gene pool, raising a mature generation is defined as one of the priority directions of the state policy. In a short period of time, large-scale practical actions in this area began to bear fruit. It is known that the physical culture system of our country was a part of the ruling system of the former Union until 1991, and our country did not have the

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right to independently enter the international arena and demonstrate its capabilities in this matter. Only a few athletes of our republic could participate in the Olympic Games, prestigious world and European competitions. The main focus was not on training qualified athletes from the local population, popularizing physical education, but on inviting qualified athletes from other republics to the farm and getting certain results. Therefore, some work was done only in the central cities of the republic, and not enough importance was given to the development of sports in the remote areas. The issue of the defense of our country also imposes a number of requirements on the physical education process established in our society, as a result of which the objective characteristics of the physical education system are revealed. All-round physical training and well-developed physical qualities of the people of our country serve as an indicator of readiness for the defense of the Motherland. Thus, the purpose of physical education in Uzbekistan is to educate the people of Uzbekistan to become physically mature, active builders of the legal state, ready for creative work and defense of the Motherland. This goal is common to all organizations and institutions implementing physical education in the country. The level of development of physical culture in the society is evaluated by the following indicators: - by the level of inculcation of physical culture in the daily life of the members of the society; - with health and physical fitness of society members; material and technical provision of physical culture training and their quality; with the permanent composition (staff), qualification and activity and talent of the employees leading the physical culture; - is evaluated by the results of the members of the society in sports.
